



Green Olive Tree Ministries (GOTM) is located in the eastern central part of Brazil. The mission was founded in 1992 by Brother Brent and Sister Debbie Freeman. The Freemans have twenty one children; sixteen are adopted and/or foster children from Brazil.



Most of the people who live in the surrounding area are very poor and illiterate. In 1998, GOTM opened a primary school for children from disadvantaged homes. Presently there are 75 children in four grades attending the school.



90% of families have no financial ability to assist in payment of school

A point system that rewards students for good behavior, attendance, etc helps these poor families. Once a certain amount of points is attained, the students receive food packages to take home to the family.
