Today, however, Everton is attending school, learning good work habits, and learning much about the love of God. He has an infectious smile which is a reflection of how he feels on the inside. His desire is to seek the will of God for his life.

Fabiano lost his parents at a very young age. His brothers and cousins were all thieves and because of the bad influence, at ten years of age, Fabiano was already carrying a gun. He was arrested many times and at one point was living in a Juvenile detention centre. Natanael, director of the home, heard about him and felt that God wanted him to accept him at the home. When Fabiano arrived, he proved to be a lot of work, but God worked in his life. Today he is one of the best behaved boys at the home. He is a hard worker, a very good student, respectful and loving. He knows the Word of God but has not made a personal commitment yet. He is now 17 and is in the 6th grade. He is behind in school not because of lack of commitment, but because of the past and his absence from school while he was young.



Maximiliano and his brother have been living at the Nepomuceno Children's home for five and half years. He is a well behaved boy, and is here because he was abused when he was living at home. His parents both are alcoholics, and did not have any way to raise them. He has made a personal commitment to give his life to Christ and has been baptized. He is a good example to the other children of what a good student and leader is.
