

# Nepomuceno Children's Home

In Brazil for many years there have been problems with children living in the streets because their parents no longer have the means to take care of them. Nepomuceno Children's Home was founded to provide a loving home for these kids, and most importantly to share with them the Gospel of Jesus Christ and His love for them. Presently Nepo finds themselves shorthanded, "The Harvest is plentiful but the workers are few." With beds for 70 kids it is sad to turn away those in need when you have staff for only 50.



The farm is of strategic importance in many ways, most importantly for food, and a place for the boys to learn how to work. Presently much effort is going into the farm to improve it.

The Barn (below) is in such a poor state that it has become more feasible to rebuild than repair.



## How Can I Help?
